VISITATION PROCEDURES

SCHEDULING

APPROVED VISITORS WILL REQUEST VISITATION BY CALLING SUMTER COUNTY CI AT 229-928-4582, PRESS ONE FOR CONTROL ROOM.

Scheduling requests may be submitted Monday -

Wednesday ONLY from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM

* One (1) visit each month per inmate will be allowed.

*Visits will be no more than two (2) hours in length.

Inmates with last names beginning A-L will visit on

* Four (4) approved visitors will be allowed and must visit

Saturday

at the same time.

9:00 AM – 11:00 AM – Saturday Session 1

* All visitors must be on the offenders approved visitation list.

12:00 PM – 2:00 PM – Saturday Session 2

* Offenders on quarantine or medical isolation status will not be allowed visits.

Inmates with the last names beginning M-Z will visit on

Sunday

9:00 AM – 11:00 AM – Sunday Session 1

12:00 PM – 2:00 PM – Sunday Session 2

ENTRY AND SCREENING

UPON ARRIVAL, VISITORS WILL PARK IN THE DESIGNATED PARKING AREA AND REMAIN IN YOUR VEHICLE

- A SCCI staff member will distribute laminated visitor numbers to each vehicle
- At your designated time, the number you have been provided will be displayed by the staff member, indicating you may leave your
- vehicle and proceed to the front entry
- Personal face coverings/masks and money must remain in your vehicle
- SCCI issued disposable masks will be provided to each visitor

ONLY FOUR (4) APPROVED VISITORS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE FRONT ENTRY AT A TIME

- Once in the front entry, you will receive a visitor badge and disposable face mask which must be worn at all times
- Only SCCI issued masks may be worn inside the facility
- All visitors must complete and sign an attestation form of no-known-illness
- All visitors will be subjected to a temporal temperature check to confirm temperatures are not greater than 100.4
- Any visitor exhibiting symptoms, unable to clear attestation form, unable to clear temperature screening will not be allowed to visit.

SAFETY AND SANITATION

VISITATION ROOM CAPACITY WILL BE LIMITED TO TEN (10) OFFENDERS, AND FOUR (4) VISITORS EACH.

- Disposable face masks will be provided, and must be worn at all times
- Seating will be socially distanced at twelve (12) feet apart
- Barriers separating offenders and loved ones will be in place
- No physical contact will be allowed
- Hand sanitizer will be available
- Vending machines will be closed
- Only one (1) person allowed in the restrooms at a time
- Laminated numbers and visitor badges will be sanitized between use
- The restrooms and visitation area will be sanitized between each visitation session
